Joy Ranch has a barn full of horses but there is more beyond the corral gates than meets the eyes! The 126-acre ranch is nestled between prairie hills on the picturesque shores of Lake Lyle, just outside of Watertown. It's more than a ranch... it is a retreat and conference center, a destination for persons with disabilities as well as a venue for equine events, weddings, family reunions, camping, birthdays and more.

Built as an 1880's prairie town, complete with main street, bunk house, hotel rooms, a historic church and school house, plus the "Thirsty Boot Saloon," the atmosphere of the ranch allows visitors to meet the "old west" head on and take part in activities and planned events such as trail rides, hiking, camping, and kayaking.

Configured to host simultaneous events, small and large gatherings, you'll find multiple conference rooms, a 250-person capacity main dining room, and commercial kitchen on site. An adept and experienced staff is available to help you plan, resource, and execute your unique or specialized event all year-round.

### **OUR MISSION**

Founder, Joy Nelson, started using horses as instruments of healing in 1989. Joy has seen the positive impact horses can have on persons who have been significantly impacted by disease or disability. Joy Ranch, a not-for-profit corporation, provides such individuals an opportunity to have a life-alter-

ing experience through the deep connection and bond when interacting with horses.

The Watertown Family Aquatic Center features a bath house with concessions, family changing rooms, and a three pool complex including a main pool with zero depth entry, lap area, floatable, 3/4 meter diving board, drop slide, water walk, frog slide, in-water playground and four additional interactive play features.

There is a special place built just for young children. The completely zero-depth entry Adventure Pool boasts four interactive play features to keep the young ones cool in the Watertown sun. The maximum depth is only 1" to ensure the safety of the little ones.

Looking for more? Cruise on over to the beach-like Sand Play Area, where you will find play structures, water, buckets and shovels to create wonderful castles and more.

For those who are craving the true thrill of water, speed down one of our three slides: fly down the Open Flume Body Slide, try the heart pounding Totally Enclosed Flume Slide, or start your Lazy River trip with a ride down our Tube Slide. No matter what level of fun you are looking for, you will find it at the Aquatic Center. It is truly focused on being a family experience that you will want to relive over and over!

Explore the Zoo and watch the otters play in their Ottertown Exhibit and then take your turn playing in the KidZoo Complex, all while connecting with nature.






Arthur Calvin Mellette (23 June 1842 $\cdot$  25 May 1896) had the distinction of serving as the last governor of Dakota Territory and the first governor of the state of South Dakota.

In 1878, Mellette was appointed registrar ofthe land office in Springfield, Dakota Territory, and when the land office was moved to Watertown in May 1880, he and his family followed. In 1889 President Benjamin Harrison appointed Mellette governor of Dakota Territory, and later that same year, when South Dakota entered the union, he was elected the first governor of South Dakota.

The home Arthur and Maggie built on Prospect Hill is now beautifully restored and furnished, almost precisely as the Mellette family knew it and lived in it. Once inside the door, the visitor has stepped into early day Dakota. During the 1880's and 1890's many receptions and social gatherings graced this beautiful home. Dignitaries, political associates and friends were frequent visitors of the family. We encourage you to enjoy a step back in time with us at the Mellette House.









In 1889, a resilient Charles Goss built the Goss Opera House after fire destroyed the original building. Box seats and a beautiful serpentine balcony, still intact today, overlooked a magnificent stage with superb acoustics. Audiences filled seats for music and theater productions as well as lavish events like the Merchant's Ball.

The vibrant space slowly went dark after the Depression, and by the late 1950s, it became a largely forgotten part of Watertown's history. Nearly 70-years after going dark, a small group of friends rallied thousands to help preserve the history of the Goss Opera House and bring life back to the space.

Every inch of the historic building was restored in an extensive \$5MM renovation project, ensuring future generations their own memories at the Goss. The Friends of the Goss Opera House, the non-profit that manages the care of this landmark is committed

to preserving this magnificent building for all to enjoy.

Because of the vision of Charles Goss and the tenacity of our community, the Goss Opera House remains the heart of Downtown Watertown. You're invited to make your own memories at the Goss.



# CODINGTON COUNTY HERITAGE MUSEUM



The Codington County Heritage Museum located at the corner of 1st Ave. SE and Maple Street in Downtown Watertown.

The mission of the Codington County Historical Society is to preserve, interpret, and promote the heritage of Codington County and nearby Coteau des Prairie region of Northeast South Dakota. This mission is primarily fulfilled by the operation of the Codington County Heritage Museum with its exhibits, programs and collection.

The museum's collection includes local historical artifacts and related materials. Some specific areas of the collection include paintings, prints, textiles, manuscripts and more than 3,000 photographs. Many of these items are rotated on display. The museum staff provides group tours, research assistance, historical presentations and programs.


Permanent exhibits include a Late 19th Century Victorian Home, a local bank, a one-room schoolhouse and military conflicts from the Civil War through Operation Desert Storm. Several temporary exhibits change on a continual basis.


The museum building, formerly a Carnegie Library built in 1906, is listed on the National Historic Register of Historic Places and is one of the best examples of neoclassical architecture in Watertown. Admission is free, but donations are gratefully accepted. 
Watertown Artwalk will be placing 15 new sculptures this spring around the downtown streets and the three offsite locations. This year, we are excited to feature a sculpture, I Lift My Eyes to the Hills, from local artist Doris Symens Armstrong. Other sculptures for the 2021-22 season include: Reeds by Bobbie Carlyle, Paper Boy, by Lee Leunig & Sherri Treeby; Food Chain by Jerry Nelson and Ralph Moose by Martha Pettigrew.



The Veterans Memorial is one of the top highlights in Watertown. A definite site-to-see while visiting or entertaining friends. The Memorial has grown with the installation of the beginning of a second wall having over 2600 names to date and will accommodate hundreds of veterans' names for years to come. From its inception in 2003, the dedication in 2006, and the addition of an Army Cobra helicopter, the Memorial has been enhanced even further.

This is a living memorial for all veterans that are interested in having their name on our memorial. The veteran needs an honorable discharge after serving 90 days in any branch of service including National Guard and Merchant Marine. Veteran names are not only from Watertown, but also from 38 states including Hawaii, Germany and Great Britain. There are names of veterans from the Civil War as well as veterans currently serving. # A LASTING LEGACY

Americana Artist Terry Redlin – A Look Back By Steve Weisman, Free-Lance Writer



In the mid-80s, Charles Redlin began pressuring his dad to save his original oils. Charles had a dream of his own and as Terry, with a grin, said, "Chuck had to fight us every step of the way." Charles wanted to build an art center as a tribute to the works of his father.

"I wanted to do something really big," says Charles. He spent years drawing and designing until by May of 1992, he built a model of what would become the present-day Redlin Art Center.

However, the original plan was to build it just off of 494 in the Twin Cities. With Terry and Helene wanting to move back Watertown, Charles reconsidered and went to the city of Watertown with







the idea. "They provided the land and have been a wonderful partner in this venture."


In retrospect, the move was perfect. "It's right off of I-29 and is a focal point here in Watertown," adds Charles.

Both Terry and Charles wanted the Center to be a gift back to the city of Watertown and the state of South Dakota for the

support and scholarship that helped Terry attend art school.

The Redlin Art Center opened June 6, 1997 and has welcomed over 3 million guests. As a 501(c)3 non-profit foundation, the Redlin Art Center relies on gift shop revenue to fund its daily operation. It was the Redlin family's desire to keep admission free.



There is no admission charge, but the Optimist Club accepts free will donations, used to make the Winter Wonderland better for years to come!






### **Holiday Lighted Parade**



If your firearms skills have diminished a bit, perhaps a trip to the Watertown Shooting Complex will help. It features a multitude of bays with baffles above and dirt berms that separate the bays. There is no charge to use the facility. The complex includes:

- Two 100-yard bays with 10 lanes each

- Two pistol bays with (8) 25-yard lanes
- One 200-yard bay with 5 lanes






