- Deb read the January Financials
 - We have \$177,925 in Plains Checking
 - Plains Money Market is \$80,949
 - Accrued interest on CD's is \$5,166
 - January Funds from City of \$17,570 Will be received in February 2023
 - \$65 due to the CVB
 - \$65-Marketing funds for 2022
 - Retained earnings \$420,565
 - Total expense of \$44,005 through Jan 31, 2023
 - Net Loss of \$25,881 through Jan 31, 2023
- Lynn mentioned that the bank had an 11 Month CD @ 4% but we don't have anything due till 2024
 - Julie made a motion to approve the financial report, Lynn 2nd, all approved.

- Lynn said the hoteliers want to fill the hotels
 - \$2 /hotel night
 - Help grow your event
 - Winter doesn't bring a lot of people into town
 - Our goal os to fill the hotels on the weekends in the winter
- Paul said we get about 550 people and are pushing for 1000 people

- Twon night stay the further away they are and they play early in the morning
- Nic said hes been coaching for 7-yrs
- Lynn said you couldn't expand if you don't have the financials
- They won't cap the summer games
 - \$290/team, plus \$25 for each official
